

How to Cite a Website in MLA

Structure:

Last name, First name. "Article Title." *Website Title*. Publisher of Website, Day Month Year article was published.

Web. Day Month Year article was accessed. <URL>.

Example:

Cain, Kevin. "The Negative Effects of Facebook Communication." *Social Media Today* Research Central, 29 June 2012. Web. 02 Jan. 2013. <www.thisexampleofawebsiteaddress.com>.

You can also use the insert citation option on the References tab of Microsoft Word.

Add new source and be sure to use the drop down box to select web site.

- You must include the title of the article or webpage
- You must include the date you accessed the article on line (if various dates pick the first date)
- You must include the URL
